

## Statewide Poll — Crosstabulations

*Oregon Statewide Likely Republican Primary Voters · n = 656 · MoE ±3.83%*

This crosstabulations document presents the seven core questions of the Predict Oregon May 7–13, 2026 statewide poll broken out by age, gender, ideology, region, and ballot status. The TOTAL column for each table reconciles to the figures reported in the published Topline. Banner-column percentages are weighted to the same 51.5% male / 48.5% female benchmark applied throughout the poll. Cells with a base smaller than 50 respondents should be read as directional only and are flagged in the methodology footer.

The seven tables on the following pages mirror the Topline question order. Tables 1–3 measure candidate preference (combined preference among decided voters and leaners; ballots already cast; and stated vote intent among voters still holding ballots). Tables 4–6 break out favorability ratings for the three candidates with broad name recognition. Table 7 reports who respondents believe will win the May 19 primary.
